REGARDING PLACENTIA LIBRARY DISTRICT'S BOARD VACANCY

The Placentia Library District ("District") is now seeking candidates to fill a vacancy on its Board of Library Trustees for District 1. This is an exciting opportunity to contribute to the District's mission, advocate for community needs, and help shape the future library services for our Placentia community.

The person selected by the Board of Library Trustees as the best candidate will be recommended to the Orange County Supervisors for appointment and if appointed, would serve for a four-year term which expires December 2028. The applicant for this position must be a Placentia resident. The Placentia Library District is an Independent Special District, governed by a five member, elected Board of Library Trustees who promulgate policies and regulations for the District as well as establish the District's budget. The Board of Library Trustees meets the fourth Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the Placentia Library Meeting Room, 411 East Chapman Avenue.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a resident of District 1.
- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Should have a strong interest in supporting library initiatives and fostering community engagement.
